May is Better Hearing and Speech Month

In support of Better Hearing and Speech Month (BHSM), join the National Institute on Deafness and Other Communication Disorders (NIDCD) in raising awareness about hearing, voice, speech, and language disorders.

A research team led by Zheng-Yi Chen, an HMS associate professor of otolaryngology and associate scientist in the Eaton-Peabody Laboratories at Mass Eye and Ear, reported creating a drug-like cocktail of different molecules that successfully regenerated hair cells in a mouse model by reprogramming a series of genetic pathways within the inner ear.

Both email and text messages were subject to a "Phishing" expedition, a scamming technique known to our bank. Although the attempt failed, we were reminded of the need to confirm the source as valid – this time by simply picking up the phone.

A good source of information about recognizing and preventing scams is the frequently updated Federal Trade Commission website, www.consumer.ftc.gov.
