HLAA tips for managing hearing loss during the holidays.

- Be well-rested to hear your best at gatherings.
- Ensure you can view everyone's face and read lips by sitting toward the center of the table

SMARTPHONE CAPTIONS

At last month's meeting, we were introduced to *Olelo*, for captioning mobile phone conversations. If you have trouble hearing on your smart phone, you will want to learn about *Olelo*, the new captioning app for smartphones. Representatives from CaptionCall introduced us to *Olelo* and explained how to set it up on our own phones.

Whether it is an Android phone or an iPhone, *Olelo* captions both sides of a conversation via AI to make your understanding easier, more accurate, and much more enjoyable.

A couple of things to note: Sharon King was instrumental in getting CaptionCall representatives in to describe their product and instruct us in its use. As our Chapter does not usually recommend specific brands, there are other such applications such as InnoCaption and Nagish, so if you have experience with any other captioned cell phone app, please consider bringing them in as well. As a further note, the company is re-branding their product as CaptionCall Mobile so don't be misled, it's the same product that was demoed.
