Introducing the Work of Child's Voice



You are invited to this interesting and important presentation by Wendy Deters, MS, CCC/SLP, Executive Director of Child's Voice School. Wendy is the daughter of the HLAA Chicago North Shore Chapter members Carol and Andy Ban.

As a Certified Speech, Language Pathologist, she will explain how young children, ages 3-8, with hearing loss are taught to develop listening skills and how to speak. These basic abilities enable them to progress to their local mainstream schools, and to benefit throughout their lives socially, academically and in their work.

The mission of *Child's Voice* is to empower children with hearing loss to be successful in all educational and social settings by optimizing their listening, speaking, and academic skills. *Child's Voice* strives to be recognized as a global leader in listening and spoken language education.

Child's Voice is the only non-public program offering listening and spoken language education in northern Illinois. *Child's Voice* serves about 400 children and their families annually from more than 30 different school districts in the Chicago area.

There will be live captioning in the Weber Room, which is equipped with a hearing loop.
